Dear Friends,

Another month, and many miles have passed since my last letter. We spent a very productive time in Florida with Marc Carr and the fellowship there. A number of us worked very hard for several days to pack the medicines for Haiti and the Dominican Republic in preparation for our next medical outreach.

While in Sarasota, Florida we stayed with, and were blessed by our friends David and Nicole Domnick. Not only were we treated like royalty, but they also gave us a trailer full of beautiful cabinets to install in our new place in Valles, Mexico. We were also blessed to be able to meet with the fellowship that they pastor in their home.

As I stated in my last correspondence, Dr. Heinlein and I returned to Houston from Florida in order for him to have a follow-up medical visit. Thank God, he passed the check-up with flying colors and a clean bill of health, and is feeling better, and stronger with each passing day.

After picking up medicines in Tulsa, Oklahoma for use in Mexico, we headed north for Ontario, Canada. There we were blessed to be able to spend a week with my parents, and our friends at Listowel Community Church. Not only did we have a wonderful time of sharing our vision for the work in Mexico and Haiti, but I was also able to begin the legal procedures involved in establishing a joint outreach between Earthen Vessels, Inc. and Listowel Community Church. As I am working with a U.S. agency this is required in order for Listowel Fellowship to be my sending church.

Dr. Heinlein and I, along with several others, fly out of Florida on the 2nd of November for Haiti. There we will meet with two other friends who will also assist with this outreach. The medical team will consist of one doctor and two nurses and as such should run very smoothly. We will have a very tight schedule there and will be holding a minimum of fourteen clinics, with a probability of quite a few more. Pray for us, and especially for Dr. Heinlein, that his health will allow him to perform at this pace.

Our plans are to arrive in Haiti on the 2nd of November and stay until the 27th of November. From there we will return to Sarasota, Florida and then back to Houston where Dr. Heinlein has a medical follow-up scheduled for the 1st of December. From there we plan to make a short trip back down to Valles, Mexico in order to touch base with the church there before the new year.

Again, I thank each one of you who has given so generously and graciously to the work. Please continue to hold us up in your prayers as nothing can be accomplished without prayer. You are very much a partner in what ever we are able to accomplish for the Lord, and we are unable to do anything without your help. May God bless you richly.
